

# Continuing Competence Program Notice

## Going on leave? Expectations for completing the **DO.LEARN.GROW.** activities

While on leave, will you remain registered on the General Register?

**Yes**

If you remain on the General Register while on leave but are not working, the following program rules applies:

*Each registration year, prior to renewing their practice permit, all regulated members on the General Register are required to satisfactorily complete one Self-Selected Activity and one College-Selected Activity, including all associated record of participation. Satisfactory completion of both activities is a condition for the renewal of a practice permit.*

### What this means for you.

Despite not working, you are still registered and required to complete the **DO.LEARN.GROW.** activities:

- **Self-Selected Activity:** complete one activity and record your learning in the Practice Improvement Record.
- **College-Selected Activity:** varies each year.

### Before you cancel your registration

You are accountable for completing the **DO.LEARN.GROW.** activities required during the registration year. Despite your intention to cancel your registration at the end of the registration year, you must complete the activities as if you were renewing.

It is expected that before you cancel your registration you will have:

- Completed one **Self-Selected Activity** and recorded your learning in the Practice Improvement Record. The Practice Improvement Record for the current registration year is available in the Member Portal only until September 30 of that year.
- Completed the **College-Selected Activity**.

### Returning to practice

When you apply to reinstate your registration, you will be required to demonstrate that you completed the required activities for the last year registered. If you have not, it may significantly delay your reinstatement application.
